SCHOLARSHIP

The 2018 ABEA Scholarship will be awarded at the Business Meeting Breakfast at the 2018 SBEA Convention. An applicant must be a currently enrolled graduate student in Business Education and must show evidence of membership in ABEA, SBEA, and NBEA. A completed application must include:

- data sheet to include earned degree, work experience, awards and honors, and other helpful information
- narrative of no more than 500 words stating the applicant's career goals
- three letters of reference
